- Animals moving
- Your own footsteps

LOOKING DOWN

- Small stone
- Animal tracks
- Flower
- Mushroom
- Signs of animal's home
- Bug
- Acorn or pinecone

FEELING

- Smooth tree trunk
- Rough tree trunk
- Something cold
- Something warm
- Rough leaves
- Smooth or soft leaves
- Moss or grass
